



UbuntuNet-IEEAF MOU

- v. IEEAF will grant access to UbuntuNet to current and future capacity they may hold globally or within the African continent.
- vi. IEEAF will support UbuntuNet capacity building plans through the provision of expert personnel as well as opportunities for training attachments to advanced networks.
- vii. IEEAF and UbuntuNet will reciprocate with "official collaboration" status. For the term of this agreement, IEEAF will recognize UbuntuNet as an "IEEAF Affiliate"; and UbuntuNet will extend reciprocal recognition to IEEAF. Any fees normally associated with such recognition shall be waived by the parties.

Administrative Issues

- i. This MoU will run for a period of two years, and may be renewed through the mutual consent of the parties
- ii. This MoU may be modified at any time through the mutual consent of the parties.
- iii. In the event of termination, confidentiality requirements as agreed shall survive the termination.



